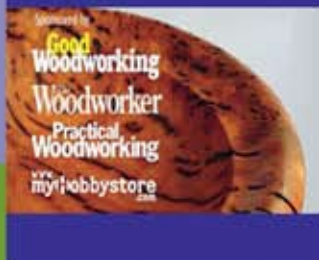

Now's the time to make a start on your competition entries for our London show in March 2010. With such great prizes on offer, there's no excuse not to have a go!

THE PRIZES

We've divided the competition into two categories – **Prestige** and **Enthusiast**. Enter the first category if you have entered previous turning competitions; enter the second if you are an amateur turner with no previous competition experience. There are three prizes for each category.

FIRST PRIZE

A woodturning, painting or photography course run by **Craft Supplies** at Le Moulin de la Materette in the Ariège region of the French Pyrenees. The course features five half-days of expert tuition during a six-day stay that includes bed, breakfast and evening meal for the prizewinner and his or her partner.

Le Moulin de la Materette is set in 10 acres of tranquil private grounds, with all the leisure facilities you could hope for, including a large heated swimming pool. The rooms are all tastefully converted and have their own private facilities.

The prize does not include travel, but inexpensive flights are available with RyanAir and other carriers. Le Moulin is an 80-minute drive from Carcassonne or Toulouse airports.

COMPETITION RULES

- The competitions are open to all readers in Great Britain, Northern Ireland, Eire, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man.

- Entries must not have been featured in competitive events at other national woodworking shows.



■ Each entry costs £2, and all proceeds will go to London's Great Ormond Street Hospital for Children.

■ All entries must be delivered to the MyHobbyStore stand at the show by 3pm on Saturday March 13, when the £2 entry fee can be paid.

■ Small items can be entered by post to our editorial office (address below), in which case the cost of entry, return postage and insurance in transit must be paid in advance by the entrant.

■ The competition will be judged by our demonstrators, whose decision is final.

■ Judging will take place on the morning of Sunday March 14.
