## THE PRIZES

We've divided the competition into two categories – **Prestige** and **Enthusiast**. Enter the first category if you have entered previous turning competitions; enter the second if you are an amateur turner with no previous competition experience. There are three prizes for each category.

There will also be a special prize for turners under 18; a hand-crafted wooden trophy made by master turner Bob Chapman.

## FIRST PRIZE

A woodturning, painting or photography course run by **Craft Supplies** at Le Moulin de la Materette in the Ariège region of the French Pyrenees. The course features five half-days of expert tuition during a six-day stay that includes bed, breakfast and evening meal for the prizewinner and his or her partner.

Le Moulin de la Materette is set in 10 acres of tranquil private grounds, with all the leisure facilities you could hope for, including a heated swimming pool. The rooms have their own private facilities.

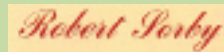
